

BRIDLE TRAILS NEIGHBORHOOD AREA PROFILE

The Bridle Trails Neighborhood Area is Bellevue's equestrian community, with acres of residential property devoted to horse pastures and trails. The area is heavily wooded, and includes an extensive trail system, as well as the 482-acre Bridle Trails State Park, which provides 28 miles of equestrian and pedestrian trails. Nearly two-thirds of Bridle Trails is covered with second-growth timber, and additional regulation protects trees on public and private property in the area. There is a predominance of large, single-family lots, in Bridle Trails, which contributes to the area's quiet, semi-rural appearance; however, the area also includes a strip of apartments and condominiums along 148th Avenue NE, across from the Microsoft campus. The Neighborhood Area includes the neighborhoods of Bellemead, Pikes Peak, Northrup Heights, Cherry Crest, Compton Trails, Compton Green, Canter Green, ShadowWood, Cambridge, Trails End and North Creek.

Approximately 54 percent of residents, ages five and older, speak a language other than English at home, including Chinese-Mandarin, Spanish, Russian and Hindi. Of the 10,648-people living in Bridle Trails, about 44 percent identify as Asian, 43 percent identify as White, six percent as Hispanic and four percent as Black or African American. About 61 percent of Bridle Trails residents were born in a foreign country, of which 74 percent were born in Asia, 14 percent were born in Europe, and six percent were born in Latin America. The most common household type in the area is married couples without children, at 36 percent, followed by married couples with children at 30 percent, and singles at 17 percent. The largest age group in the area is 18 to 44-year-olds (49%), followed by 45 to 64-year-olds (21%), and those under 18 (19%). Educational attainment in the area is high, with nearly 76 percent of residents 25 years old and older holding a bachelor's degree or higher. Approximately 95 percent of the area's 4,671 households are occupied.
