



TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS COMING TO WOODRIDGE


All-way stop coming to 128th Ave SE/SE 26th Pl intersection

February 2018

In the coming weeks, crews will install stop signs and pavement markings at 128th Ave SE and SE 26th Pl in Woodridge creating an all-way stop control for motorists.

Stop signs currently exist for the eastbound and westbound directions of SE 26th Place. Crews will install additional stop signs for the northbound and southbound directions of 128th Avenue SE, making this intersection an all-way stop. A crosswalk is also being added to the south side of the intersection and warning signs installed to raise attention to the new all-way stop. The installation of these signs will help to improve both pedestrian and vehicle safety and traffic flow.

The installation of an all-way stop is the first phase of traffic improvements coming to the Woodridge neighborhood. With help from a group of resident volunteers, city staff are also developing a plan to discourage commuter traffic from using Woodridge streets as a bypass to Richards Road. An update on future improvements will be mailed in the coming months.
