

Coal Creek Natural Area

Stepping into Coal Creek Natural Area is like stepping into the past. Immersed under a treed canopy without a house in sight the park echoes of the wildness that once covered this area. You can almost hear clanging coal cars as you wander through the second growth forest. Look closely and take time to discover evidence of the early coal industry along the trail. Coal Creek provides valuable fish and wildlife habitat. The dense forest protects water quality and erosion. The trail system provides opportunities for passive recreation and environmental education.
